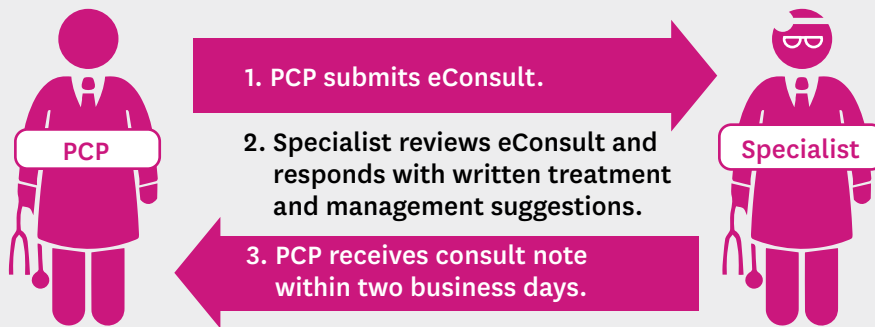
Health Net* and CalViva Health are pleased to offer eConsults (electronic consultations), a no-cost specialty care resource, to support Medi-Cal members.

What is an eConsult?

An eConsult is a concurrent exchange between a primary care physician (PCP) and a specialist. A PCP can consult with a specialist about a patient electronically to initiate care immediately. A digital referral, along with clinical information, images, lab results and other content from the medical record, is sent directly to a specialist. A complete consult is returned within two business days. In 70%–75% of cases, an eConsult will result in PCP management instead of referring the patient for a face-to-face visit with a specialist.

How eConsult works:

- No additional technology or platform access required.
- Protected health information (PHI) included.
- Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA)-compliant.
- No prior authorizations required.
