Language Assistance Program	Alvishia Johnson (Health Equity Specialist) provided an overview of the language assistance program and described the different types of interpretation services, including face-to-face, telephone, video, and sign language interpretations. She explained the various language assistance services, including written translations, oral translations, and alternate formats. The importance of filing grievances if language needs are not met is emphasized. Additionally, Ms. Johnson explained the process for scheduling interpreters and the availability of interpretation services 24/7.		
Health Net Population Health Management & Community	Tianna Arbulu and Eliana Argueta (Regional Program Managers) discussed the Community Reinvestment Plan (CRP), including its alignment with the Community		

Reinvestment Update	Health Assessment (CHA) and Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP). In Amador County, the focus is on increasing access to care and community connectedness, with mobile service events and patient navigator positions funded. In Calaveras County, the goal is to increase postpartum visits, with investments in an annual health summit and outreach programs. In Inyo County, the focus is on improving childhood immunization status, with investments in outreach programs and culturally tailored education. In Mono County, the goal is to promote the completion of well-child visits, with investments in outreach programs and culturally tailored education. In Tuolumne County, the focus is on reducing opioid-related deaths, with investments in naloxone training, harm reduction education, and opioid safety coalition support. A committee member discussed the need for more doctors and specialists in rural counties. The Plan responded by highlighting our commitment to serving rural communities and the importance of community reinvestment. In response to member feedback and questions related to Community Reinvestment, the Health Net team offered to provide a future presentation highlighting the plan's investments and ongoing engagement in the rural region, including efforts related to housing, social drivers of health, and access to care. Lastly, Ms. Arbulu shared information regarding the upcoming Smile Dental service days – a mobile Dental clinic servicing Amador County.	Health Net will send flyer out to CAC.
