Health Net will be implementing this system in 2026.</li> <li>Committee members are requesting for a resource that will assist members in identifying LGBTQ+ providers. Field Testing – Fluvention Email	<ul> <li>Armine Kelechian (Senior Health Equity Specialist) field tested a flu prevention email campaign directed to Members Committee members were given the opportunity to provide feedback on the email language and format.</li> <li>The majority of Committee members recommended this email for distribution and understood the messaging.
