## ZERO COST DRUGS AND DEVICES UNDER THE AFFORDABLE CARE ACT (ACA)

**Aspirin to help prevent illness and death from preeclampsia in persons who are at least 12 years old, after 12 weeks of pregnancy and are at high risk for the condition.**

**Generic dosage forms of 81 mg**

**Aspirin products**

- Aspirin chew tab 81 mg
- Aspirin enteric coated tab 81 mg

**Fluoride Supplements**

**All oral dosage forms up to 0.5 mg Fluoride products**

- Sodium fluoride chew tabs 0.25 mg to 0.5 mg
- Sodium fluoride solution 0.5 mg/ml
- Sodium fluoride tablet 0.5 mg

**Folic Acid Supplements to help prevent birth defects in women† age 55 or younger who are planning to become pregnant or can become pregnant.**

**Generic dosage forms**

**Tobacco Cessation Products** to help adults who are not pregnant quit tobacco use.

- *Sodium sulfate/potassium sulfate/magnesium sulfate (SUPREP)*
- *Polyethylene glycol-3350-potassium chloride sodium bicarb-sodium chloride- sodium sulfate for soln 236 gm (GOLYTELY, GAVILYTE-G)*
- *Bisacodyl tabs 5mg*
- *Bisacodyl suppositories*
- *Polyethylene glycol-3350-Potassium Chloride-Sodium Bicarb-sodium chloride for Soln 420 GM (GAVILYTE-N)*
