
- Patient safety practices and complication rates.



- In the Compare Hospital search field, enter a hospital's name or your ZIP code. Click the search icon.
- Click on the hospital's name in the left bar. A page of information on the hospital will open.

Click on Leapfrog Hospital Ratings.

• To compare hospitals, search by area or name. (Note that some hospitals are not rated on Leapfrog's tool because they did not submit survey results.)





Some hospitals that are featured on Cal Hospital Compare and Leapfrog are **not** part of your plan's network.


