

**FIRST AMENDMENT

PROGRAM RELATING TO WIC SERVICES**

This First Amendment (“Amendment”) to the Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) by and between the Kaiser Foundation Health Plan, Inc., Health Net Community Solutions, Inc., and San Joaquin County Health Commission doing business as Health Plan of San Joaquin and Mountain Valley Health Plan (“MCP”) and Community Medical Centers, Inc. Women, Infants, & Children (“WIC”) Program Relating to WIC Services, collectively the “Parties,” is entered into on February 12, 2026, but shall be effective as of November 18, 2025 (the “Amendment Effective Date”).

WHEREFORE, the Parties entered into the MOU dated November 18, 2025, which describes the responsibilities of MCPs and WIC with respect to data sharing;

WHEREFORE, in accordance with Section 14. f. of the MOU, the Parties desire to amend the MOU to reflect changes to comply with DHCS requirements

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereby mutually agree to amend the MOU as follows:

1. Adding the following to Section 4.b.vi as written below:
"The contact information for the MCP-Agency Liaison can be found in the P&Ps."
2. Adding the following to Section 5.b. as written below:
"The contact information for the Agency Liaison can be found in the P&Ps"
3. In the event of a conflict between the terms of this Amendment and the terms of the MOU in prior to the Amendment Effective Date, the terms of this Amendment shall control. Except as amended herein, all terms and conditions of the MOU shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect the same as if this Amendment had not been executed. Unless otherwise specified in this Amendment, all capitalized terms shall have the meaning given to them in the MOU.



- 4. This Amendment may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Counterparts may be delivered via facsimile, electronic mail, or other transmission method, and may include the delivery of an electronic or original signature. The Parties agree that any counterpart so delivered shall be deemed to have been duly and validly delivered and be valid and effective for all purposes.
