**NOTICE:**

This letter is to let you know about behavioral and medical health plan changes as of April 1, 2014.

As an American Indian you are eligible to receive your behavioral health services from a Tribal Regional Behavioral Health Authority (TRBHA) or the Maricopa Regional Behavioral Health Authority (RBHA). Your choice for behavioral health services will change if you are currently receiving behavioral health services with Magellan of Arizona. Effective April 1, 2014, the Maricopa RBHA will change from Magellan of Arizona to Mercy Maricopa Integrated Care. You may also be able to enroll in Mercy Maricopa Integrated Care for your medical health care needs.

Effective April 1, 2014, if you are currently enrolled in an **AHCCCS Health Plan** and receiving behavioral health services through a RBHA, you will be automatically enrolled in Mercy Maricopa Integrated Care for your behavioral health and medical health care needs. Your current AHCCCS Health Plan will continue to be responsible for your medical health care needs through March 31, 2014. The current Maricopa RBHA, Magellan of Arizona will continue to be responsible for your behavioral health care needs through March 31, 2014.

If you are currently enrolled with the **AHCCCS American Indian Health Program**, you may choose to receive your behavioral health services from a TRBHA or Mercy Maricopa Integrated Care beginning April 1, 2014. However, you will not be eligible to receive your medical health care services from Mercy Maricopa Integrated Care unless you call to change your health plan from American Indian Health Program to Mercy Maricopa Integrated Care. To change, you can call AHCCCS customer service (Monday - Friday 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.) at (602) 417-7100 from area codes (602), (623), (480). Call 1-800-962-6690 from any other area codes.

As always, if you are American Indian you are able to receive medical health care services from any Indian Health Service provider or tribally operated 638 facilities at any time whether you are enrolled in Mercy Maricopa Integrated Care or the American Indian Health Program.
