# Common Questions and Useful Answers!

#### How do I enroll?

To get specific information about the enrollment process at your agency, contact your agency Human Resources Office.

Please review these frequently asked questions to help you decide which plan option works best for you and your family.

# What are the differences between the High, Standard and Basic Option HMO plans?

The main differences between the plans are their copayment variations for certain services. On the High and Standard Option plans, you must select a provider from Health Net's ExcelCare HMO Network. For the Basic Option plan, you must choose from Health Net's Salud HMO y Más Network.

#### How do I know which providers are in my area?

A list of participating medical groups and hospitals within 30 miles of your home or work address will be distributed during Open Enrollment meetings. This means you can choose a doctor who's convenient to get to when you need care.

This listing is a general guide only and is subject to change. Please confirm that the medical group and doctor are affiliated with the hospital listed. For more information, visit www.healthnet.com/fehb.

# How do I know if I live in the ExcelCare HMO or Salud HMO y Más service area?

### How do I find a provider in the network?

## How can I save on health care costs with health plans offered by Health Net?

Our plans do not have a deductible. This means that whatever the copayment amount your plan shows for a covered benefit, that is the amount you will pay without having to satisfy a predetermined amount (or deductible) before enjoying your benefits.

Our plans do have an out-of-pocket maximum (OOPM). This is a maximum amount a member will spend on medical copayments or coinsurance during the calendar year. The maximum for High and Standard Options is \$1,500 for self, \$3,000 for self plus one and \$4,500 per family. The maximum for the Basic Option is \$4,500 for self, \$9,000 for self plus one and \$9,000 per family. The prescription drug maximum for High and Standard Options is \$2,900 for individual or \$8,700 per family. The prescription drug maximum for Basic Option is \$2,000 for individual or \$4,000 per family.

Health Net tracks your paid copayments for prescription drugs. However, it is your responsibility to keep a record of the medical copayments and coinsurance that you have paid. When you feel you have satisfied the OOPM, contact Health Net's Customer Contact Center. We will request copies of your medical receipts, and, if you have satisfied the OOPM, we will notify the providers that no further medical copayments or coinsurance are necessary for the balance of the year.


