You are eligible to enroll in Health Net Ruby Select (HMO) if:

- You are entitled to Medicare Part A and enrolled in Medicare Part B. Members must continue to pay their Medicare Part B premium, if not otherwise paid for under Medicaid or by another third party.
- You must be a United States citizen, or are lawfully present in the United States and permanently reside in the service area of the plan (in other words, your permanent residence is within the Health Net Ruby Select (HMO) service area county). Our service area includes the following counties in California: San Francisco County.
- You do not have end-stage renal disease (ESRD).

The Health Net Ruby Select (HMO) plan gives you access to our network of highly skilled medical providers in your area. You can look forward to choosing a primary care provider (PCP) to work with you and coordinate your care. You can ask for a current Provider Directory or, for an up-to-date list of network providers, visit <https://ca.healthnetadvantage.com>. (Please note that, except for emergency care, urgently needed care when you are out of the network, out-of-area dialysis services, and cases in which our plan authorizes use of out-of-network providers, if you obtain medical care from out-of-plan providers, neither Medicare nor Health Net will be responsible for the costs).

This plan uses specific providers only. Not all participating Medical Groups and their affiliated primary care providers (PCPs) and facilities are available to you in the service area for this plan. In addition, you may be limited to providers within your PCP's and/or medical group's network. This means that the PCP and/or medical group that you choose may determine the specialists and hospitals you can use. It is important to understand that Health Net offers a variety of plans in each service area; if your provider of choice is not available through this plan, the provider may be available through a different Health Net plan offering.
